Objectives

Our key objectives are:

2. Heritage places and objects in the ACT Region are identified and conserved appropriately
3. We are recognised as a trustworthy leader in the conservation of heritage places and objects.
4. We build our strength and effectiveness, supported by sound governance and an active and committed membership.
