

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The health and safety of our visitors, volunteers and staff is of the utmost importance to us. We continue to monitor the pandemic as it affects our community and to carefully adhere to all government advice as it is issued.

Our sites are closed to the public when we are delivering school programs and are cleaned regularly. Students, staff and parents are asked *not* to attend if they are unwell or are experiencing a fever, cough, sore throat and / or shortness of breath, or are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

SCHOOLS ARE ASKED TO:

Bring

clipboards and pencils for your students

Provide

hand sanitiser for school staff and students

Consider

bringing a tarpaulin or picnic rug for student use, these will no longer be provided by the National Trust

Remind

students of good hygiene practises including

- maintaining respect for personal space
- covering coughs and sneezes with their elbow or a tissue and disposing of tissues responsibly
- washing or sanitising hands regularly

We will provide anti-bacterial wipes and students may be asked to wipe the activity tables before rotating to the next activity. Check-in, masks and proof of vaccination are not required at this time but this is subject to change as directed by the Western Australian Government.
