### Hou Wang Temple Built 1903 AD

Located in the midst of the tropical lushness of the Atherton Tablelands is the last timber and tin Chinese temple in Australia, the Hou Wang Temple. The temple features a full display of cultural artefacts to engage and educate the whole family on what was once a site of social and religious significance for the region's Chinese community. Discover the beautifully preserved artefacts within the temple as you are guided by passionate volunteers.

### James Cook Museum Historic 1770 Anchor

Housed in a stunning nineteenth century former convent, the James Cook Museum in Cooktown is one of Queensland's best museums, showcasing the fascinating history of this remarkable town. The museum's exhibits are rich and varied. The Endeavour Gallery gives a fascinating insight into the seven weeks Captain James Cook and his crew spent at the site of modern Cooktown, repairing their ship after a catastrophic grounding on nearby Endeavour Reef and interacting with the local Aboriginal people. Two highlights of the gallery are an original anchor and cannon from *HMB Endeavour*, both jettisoned from the ship in 1770 and only retrieved from the reef in the early 1970s.

### Stock Exchange Arcade

Built in 1888, the Stock Exchange building is a splendid relic of the golden age when goldfields at 'The Towers' attracted investors from all of the world. The exchange operated for 26 years until the mines closed. In the 1970s the late Don Roderick and others undertook its conservation.



### Zara Clark Museum

With displays on everything from the military presence during WWII, to the medical history of the period, the museum provides insights into the rich and diverse history of what was once one of Queensland's largest cities.



### Townsville Heritage Centre

With a collection of three residence dating from to the late 1800s, the Townsville Heritage Centre presents a fascinating insight into life in the early days of development in Queensland's north.
