Step Back in Time Community Walk

- Identify and compare features of objects from the past and present.
- Obtain appropriate consent forms etc.
- Go for a walk around the local neighbourhood to look for things students think are from the past.
- When something is identified discuss how we know it is from the past.
- Take photos of old and new in the community.
- Encourage students to look for moss, style, fading, cracks & old growth ie big tree trunks.
- Back at school write about what they learnt about what to look for when identifying signs of the past.
- Look at the photos taken on the walk contrast old features with new. Provide students with photos of something new, ask them to redraw it but as though it were very old.
- Divide students into pairs or small groups and assign each group a specific TWEEED
 (transport, work, education, environement, entertainment, daily life) topic to research.
 Give each group an A3 sheet and a photo pertinent to their topic. Each group
 brainstorms everything they know about their topic in the past and present.
- Develop inquiry questions about their topic.
