

ATHERTON CHINATOWN – HOU WANG TEMPLE

TEACHERS' CONSIDERATIONS

1. Ensure all students have name tags with large print.
2. Ensure all students have sun protection – including hats.
3. Ensure students have appropriate clothing – raincoats for wet weather, jumpers or cardigan for cool weather. (Coastal dwellers often find it cool when they visit Tablelands.)
4. The program needs to start on time. If necessary arrive earlier to allow time for toilet breaks or for morning tea before the program starts. The program may have to be shortened in the event of starting late.
5. Visit the toilets at Platypus Park or on site in the Old Post Office building before the beginning of the tour.
6. Ensure students have a backing board, pens or pencils and any necessary worksheets.
7. There is no food outlet on site, please ensure students have food with them.
8. Decide before visiting us how the account will be paid –cash, cheque, EFTPOS or direct deposit.
9. Groups will be divided up into smaller groups for activities in the museum and the temple and grounds. It is easier if this is done at school.
10. Please let the Property Manager know if there are students with special needs so that some arrangements can be made.
11. Bags, food and drinks are not permitted in the museum and the temple.
12. Teachers and carers are required to remain with their groups at all times.
13. Disciplining students remains the responsibility of teachers and carers accompanying the group.
14. Time allocations for school excursions are usually an hour and a half – 3x 30 minutes for each of the tour parts. This can be altered and negotiated if necessary.
