

COVID-19 SAFETY FOR TOURS AND EVENTS

Please check the current ACT health guidelines on protecting yourself and others before booking on a tour or event: <https://health.act.gov.au/about-our-health-system/novel-coronavirus-covid-19/protect-yourself>

Please note that you must cancel if you:

- Are sick or suffering any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Are awaiting results for or have tested positive to COVID-19.
- Have been advised to self-isolate or quarantine.
- Have recently been to a location currently listed as a COVID-affected area.

You should maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres from other people during the tour and observe good hygiene to prevent the spread of germs. If required, your contact details will be provided to health authorities. Hand sanitiser will be available.

Refunds are given if a tour is cancelled or if individuals are unable to attend due to risk of COVID (refunds may be subject to the policy of third parties in some cases)

Where applicable, any specific COVID restrictions which apply are observed, eg limits on numbers in indoor areas.

If food or drinks are served, this is done in a COVID safe way – avoiding communal/shared plates and servers, volunteers wearing disposable gloves, hand sanitiser provided.

COVID safety will be reviewed if there are changes in COVID restrictions and tours or events amended or cancelled if necessary.
