b) Announcement of Dr Francis Mace, Inaugural Prelude: Composer in Residence at Gallop House.

Ms Christine Lewis announced the new Prelude Composer in Residence for 2017 is Dr Mace Francis who, with his family, will call Gallop House home for 12 months from January 2017. She went on to explain that Mace is a well-known and talented Perth composer who has been a long-time advocate for big band music, has invested his time and energy in young musicians in Western Australia through the WA Youth Jazz Orchestra over a decade and who is an outstanding contributor to Western Australia's jazz scene. During this time Mace will focus on a new extensive composition for the WA Youth Jazz Orchestra as well as collaborative opportunities with local, national and international peers.
