




#### Old Melbourne Gaol – education guided tour

## What is the Old Melbourne Gaol?



### Arriving


When I arrive at the Old Melbourne Gaol and get off the bus, I will stand away from the road and listen to what my teacher says.

We will walk through an archway into a courtyard with fake grass. It might be loud in the courtyard; I might be able to hear the traffic on the street.



### Toilets

There are toilets in the courtyard, which can be accessed from a ramp. I always need to ask an adult before going to the toilet. The toilets have hand driers in them, they might be loud.



#### The tour

When it is time for our tour to start, our guide will come over and introduce themselves. Our guide will tell us all about life in the past. They might talk about things that I find scary, but I am safe.


If I have a question for the guide, I need to put my hand up.
