STRATEGIC WORK

NEW COUNCIL PARTNERSHIPS

Two new Council partnerships were developed during the 22/23 FY

Greater Bendigo City Council

VHRF Administration continued discussions with Greater Bendigo City Council for a potential partnership in the 23/24 FY following a change of management at the Council in mid 2022. Following discussions, the Council staff took a proposal to Council for a two year trial of the fund, which was approved. The GBHRF agreement (which has now been signed) is for two financial years: 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 with a minimum of two funding rounds in each financial year. There will be a review by the City of Greater Bendigo in June 2024 to determine the amount of funds available or 2024/2025.

Merri-bek Council

Merri-bek Council contacted VHRF Administration following learning about the fund from Richa Swarup at a Heritage Planning network meeting. The Prospectus was sent to the Council and further discussions were held. Subsequently Council staff took a proposal to Council for a one year trial and it was approved. The M-bHRF agreement (which is still being finalised) is for one financial year: 2023/2024 with a minimum of three funding rounds in each financial year. There will be a review by the Merri-bek City Council in June 2024 to determine if funds will be made available for future years. The M-bHRF will allocate \$50,000 in the 2023 - 2024 financial year. An administration fee of \$10,000 for 2023 – 2024 is included in this allocation of \$50,000.
