WOOLBROOK HOMESTEAD - HISTORIC STAYS

Built in 1857, Woolbrook Homestead has been home to five generations and is now opening its doors to guests wishing to experience country life at its finest.

STEAM: TRAIN CARRIAGE - HISTORIC STAYS

Working sheep farm, family owned and run by seven generations since the 1840s. The bluestone building is one of Victoria's oldest surviving homesteads.

SAILORS REST




