Completed in 1929, this heritage icon is in the heart of Melbourne's CBD. Reminiscent of a fabulously stylish New York City apartment, the Majorca Martini Suite invites you to step back in time to the Roaring Twenties.

THE WINDSOR

Established in 1883, The Windsor combines the classic beauty and architecture of the Victorian age with the graciousness of that bygone era. The heritage-protected hotel is opposite Parliament House.

RENDEZVOUS

328 Flinders St, Melbourne • rendezvousmelbourne.com.au

Built in 1913, Rendezvous is one of Australia's most historic hotels. This heritage-listed hotel is located on Flinders Street overlooking the Yarra River with many of Melbourne's top attractions within reach.

A small gin distillery located in a heritage listed red brick cottage (c1877) in the CBD. They store their gin and whisky barrels at the Old Melbourne Gaol.

THE TEA ROOMS 1892

Located in Melbourne's famous Block Arcade, The Tea Rooms are steeped in history. Opening in 1892, it is home to the oldest tearooms in Australia. Enjoy the timeless tradition of high tea, cake and sandwiches.

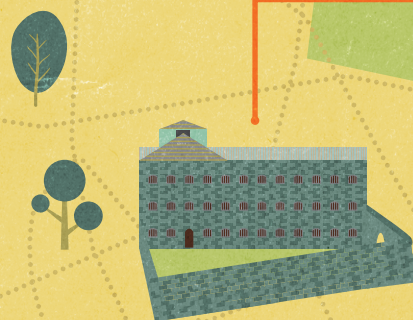
