Purpose

The purpose of the Achievement Award is to acknowledge significant contribution through voluntary work on behalf of the National Trust of South Australia. This contribution may have been made individually or through the work of a Branch, Committee, Council or the Head Office.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an Achievement Award, the Nominee must be a current financial member of the National Trust of South Australia (unless exceptional circumstances exist).

A nomination may be made by a financial member of the National Trust (the Nominator).

Examples of projects and activities which can be considered may include:

Managing an advocacy or local history project; establishing a new exhibition in a branch heritage centre / museum; working on a project in a natural heritage reserve; leading a successful fundraising or educational project or activity.

Nomination For An Award

Provide all necessary information concerning the Nominee as requested on the attached nomination form.

The names and contact details are to be provided for two financial National Trust members who also support the application.

Assessment Of The Nomination

The nomination will be assessed by the Council of the National Trust. If the application is successful, the Nominator and the Nominee will be notified. If the application is not successful, only the Nominator will be notified.
