

### **Honorary Life Membership Award Nomination Form**

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Honorary Life Membership Award is to acknowledge exceptional contribution through voluntary work on behalf of the National Trust of South Australia. This contribution may have been made individually or through the work of a Branch, Committee, Council or the Head Office.

#### Eligibility

A nomination may be made by a financial member of the National Trust (the Nominator).

The Nominator will need to demonstrate that the Nominee has demonstrated exceptional achievement in an innovative National Trust project or activity. The Life Membership award is also given in recognition of years of outstanding years of service by the Nominee.

Examples of projects and activities which can be considered may include:

Initiating a heritage tourism project, managing a successful membership drive or fundraising program; establishing an oral history project; establishing educational programs for children or for seniors, re-designing a museum space.

#### **Nomination For An Award**

Provide all necessary information concerning the Nominee as requested on the attached nomination form.

The names and contact details are to be provided for two additional financial National Trust members who support the application.

#### **Assessment Of The Nomination**

The nomination will be assessed by the Council of the National Trust. If the application is successful, the Nominator and the Nominee will be notified. If the application is not successful, only the Nominator will be notified.
