ABOUT SISTER MILLIE DORSCH

Sister Millie Dorsch was not originally from Minlaton, but trained and worked as a Nursing Sister at Minlaton Hospital for about two and a half years.

In 1940, she enlisted from Minlaton as a Lieutenant in the Australian Army Nursing Service.

Tragically, Sister Dorsch lost her life at sea in February 1942, aged just 29, while on active service.

Through this presentation we remember her service, her connection with Minlaton and her place in our shared history.
